- Your information will be included in a CAC flyer if you choose should a prospective buyer wishes to contact you privately to make inquiries.
- Work must be a floral or have a floral theme for this show and size of work up to 24" x 36" including frame.
- Application fee is \$30 which will be waived if the applicant volunteers for two hours to work at the exhibit or do demonstration painting in the booth. If you wish to work in the *Florals by Locals* booth you may bring paints and an easel and paint on site during a scheduled time period. (To volunteer or demonstrate contact the Exhibition Coordinator NEED NAME AND CONTACT INFO.)
- You may submit two pieces of art work to display. Art work MUST be ready to hang with wire on back of piece. Applications are accepted on a first come first serve basis; space is limited.
