THE SHOW YOU ARE APPLYING FOR: 2019 C3 Gallery Exhibition “50 Years Ago. . . Inspired by the events of 1969” opening September 25, 2019 through January 5, 2020.

ARTIST REQUIREMENTS:

1. Artists must be 18 or older **and** a resident of Coronado, or work, teach or own property in Coronado. (Please check)
 I am 18 or older I am a resident of Coronado I work (20 hours), teach or own property in Coronado.
2. All artwork must be original and the work of the registered applicant. May not be an alteration of another’s work or assembled from a kit.
3. Artists must submit this application, and a minimum one (but no more than 10) jpegs of work to be juried for display in exhibition. No more than five pieces of artwork may be juried into the show from each submitting artist.
4. If selected, artist shall provide accurate information for each artwork exhibited listing: title, media, year, artist name, price or NFS, phone number, email, and website, if applicable.
5. The Artist is integral in the installation of art in the display case. Artist is responsible for the delivery and pickup of their artwork at the C3 Gallery at agreed upon date and time in August.
6. All two-dimensional artwork **must** be framed or mounted and ready to hang with current gallery-hanging system. A description of the hanging system and necessary hardware will be provided to all selected artists. All works must have the artist’s name, title and medium affixed to the back of every work entered in the exhibit. Three dimensional work that require stands or holders must be provided by the artist and labeled as such.
7. Publicize and promote the exhibit and Opening Reception to their clients, contacts and the media. Artist Reception is scheduled for September 25, 2019 from 6 to 8 p.m. in the Coronado Community Center Nautilus Room at 1845 Strand Way in Coronado.
8. Complete a Waiver of Indemnity and Liability releasing the City of any liability from artwork damage, loss or theft.

Process:

Application and .jpg images must be submitted by email to kpurvis@coronado.ca.us by September 5, 2019 at 5 p.m. The selection committee will jury the applications; artists will be notified by August 15, 2019. Artwork will need to be delivered to the Coronado Community Center Art Gallery to be hung or exhibited on pre-arranged dates.

Exhibitions will run from September 25, 2019 through January 5, 2020. **All applicants will be notified of application status via email by September 15, 2019.**
